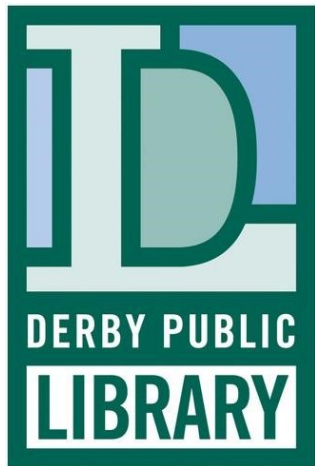

Little Red Riding Hood

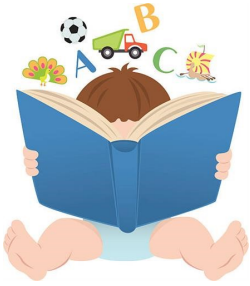

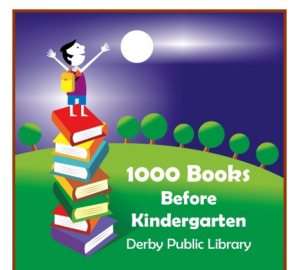
