

Process for Student Library Card Sign-Up

We can coordinate library card registration for students. Teachers may request card applications in advance of outreach visits or field trip visits to the library. We ask that teachers ensure parents give permission for their students to have a library card and to verify addresses and contact information to the best of their knowledge. Please have parents print their first and last name on the back of the application card, so we can input guardian information into our system.

Adventures @ the Library

Grades K-2 Thursdays 4-5 p.m. Explore and discover all kinds of things after school at the library with this literacy-based program for grades K-2. Program typically includes books read aloud, a craft, an activity, sometimes a short video, and snack time.

Tween Zone

Grades 3-5 Wednesdays 4-5 p.m. We welcome tweens in grades 3-5 to enjoy crafts, movies, games, snacks, and book talks. There are often passive activities such as character scavenger hunts and bookmark design contests that go along with the program.
