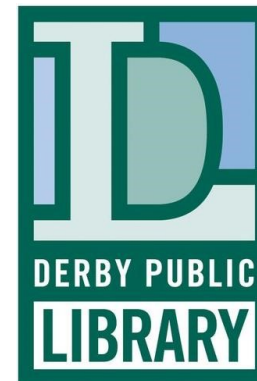

### Process for Student Library Card Sign-Up

We can coordinate library card registration for students. Teachers may request card applications in advance of outreach visits or field trip visits to the library. We ask that teachers ensure parents give permission for their students to have a library card and to verify addresses and contact information to the best of their knowledge. Please have parents print their first and last name on the back of the application card, so we can input guardian name's into our system.
